SOURCING 2020 VINTAGE NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON

OAK KNOLL – Cool San Pablo Bay breezes lead to bright red fruit characteristics – fresh cranberry

YOUNTVILLE – Creates rich red fruit flavors and big tannins – raspberry and ripe cherry

RUTHERFORD – Deep, well-draining "Rutherford dust" soils – rich chocolate flavor

CALISTOGA – Warm climate leads to dark concentrated fruit – blackberry jam, blueberry and smooth tannins

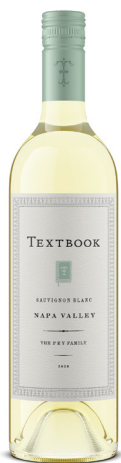
Long-Standing Relationships – Our high-caliber grower and producer partners provide us with superior lots, allowing us to consistently deliver complexity and quality vintage to vintage.

Diversity of Terroir – Winemaker Abi Horstman crafts our Napa Valley wines with fruit grown in a range of sub-appellations, providing a diverse palette of flavors and aromatics.

Iconic Neighbors – We hand harvest from two superbly mature and well-drained sites for our Oakville Collection. The Vyborny Vineyard on the rocky, east side of Oakville District AVA, next door to Screaming Eagle and the Holmes Vineyard on west side of Oakville, near To-Kalon and downslope from Harlan.

CRAFTSMANSHIP

Winemaker Abigail "Abi" Horstman honed her winemaking chops in Italy, New Zealand, and Israel and worked for prestige brands like Markham, Domaine Chandon, and Robert Mondavi in Napa Valley. She crafts our wines by keeping the lots separate, tasting them throughout the year, and then integrating the components to create balanced, complex wines that can be enjoyed independently or with various cuisines.
