## CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2022

### PASO ROBLES

“The individual lots for this wine spent months aging separately in French Oak, before I hand-selected the final blend. The result is richness yet restraint - allowing this Cabernet to be paired with an array of cuisines or simply enjoyed on its own.

On the nose, there are lovely aromas of Satsuma plum, Black cherry, and subtle graphite from Paso Robles’ mineral-rich soils. On the palate, I get the flavors of ripe red cherry, mixed berry pie, and Tahitian vanilla. The finish is smooth with well-integrated tannins. It’s opulent, richly textured, and beautifully balanced.”

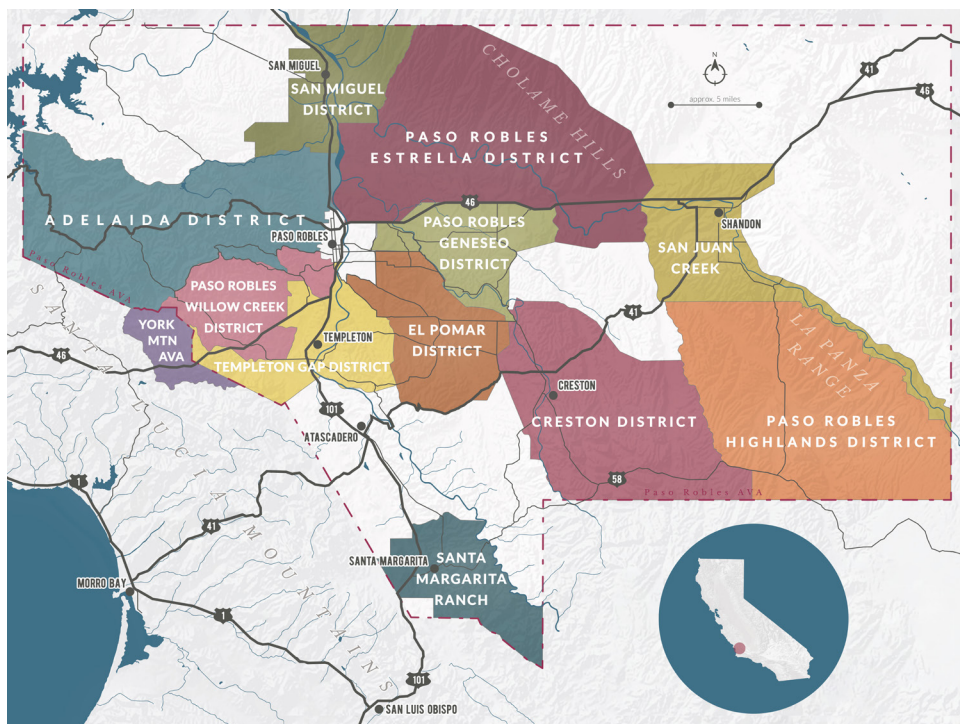

Sourced from four distinct sub-districts with unique elevations, climates, and soils:

**ESTRELLA VINEYARD, ESTRELLA DISTRICT** – Hot days and moderate evenings foster ripe fruit flavors and well-developed phenolics.

**EL POMAR DISTRICT** – Near the Templeton Gap, cool marine air allows grapes to maintain acidity and develop complexity over a prolonged growing season.

**GENESEO DISTRICT** – The warmer climate ensures tannins fully mature by harvest, resulting in powerful wines.

**SAN MIGUEL DISTRICT** – Characterized by limestone soils which imparts a distinct minerality.
