WORLD CLASS GROWING REGION *Russian River Valley AVA*

Spanning just 15 miles wide and 20 miles long, the Russian River Valley is found within the broader Sonoma County. The sub-AVA's climate is influenced by the Pacific Ocean, which lies only a few miles to the west. Nearby coastal mountain ranges act as a natural buffer from severe weather while allowing cooling maritime breezes and fog to weave through the valleys. As the evening fog dissipates each morning, the warm California sunshine ripens the fruit. This interplay of fog, sun, and ocean breeze lends to a long growing season, ensuring layered complexity and perfect ripeness at harvest.

SOURCING 2023 VINTAGE Blake's Launch Vineyard

Nestled adjacent to the meandering Russian River, the vineyard's soils benefit from its closeness to the riverbank. Its Yolo soils are deep and well-drained, formed in alluvium from mixed rocks. The vines struggle in these demanding soil conditions and produce grapes with concentration and balance.

- Hand-picked clusters were field-sorted into half-ton bins on September 21 & 25 at 22.2° Brix.
- After destemming, the fruit went directly to press for a gentle whole cluster press.
- Fermented in stainless steel for bright profile, with a small portion barrel fermented in neutral French oak for added complexity.
- Frequent bâtonnage or "stirring of the lees" achieved beautiful texture.
